

Privacy policy

PEWE BV holding and its subsidiary Slaats Asten BV, jointly referred to below as: Slaats Asten BV or Slaats BV or Slaats / we) offer many different services. Due to the nature of this service we have certain personal information about you. We believe that the protection of personal data is essential for our services. That is why we provide information in this privacy policy about how we process personal data of our customers and website visitors. This privacy policy applies to all personal data that Slaats Asten BV collects during your interactions with Slaats Asten BV: such as when you visit our website, use services offered by Slaats Asten BV, purchase Slaats Asten products and (services), subscribe to newsletters, contacting customer service and so on.

What we use your data for

Slaats Asten BV only uses your personal data to make efficient and effective business operations possible. We ask you to share your personal information with us for the following purposes, but not limited to:

- to answer your questions or complaints
- optimizing our products, services, website and customer service
- to establish and execute an agreement with you
- to activate, register or expand certain products or services
- facilitating access to information
- compliance with legal obligations
- the purchase of a customer satisfaction survey
- to contact you for promotional purposes, including sending newsletters and invitations to events
- to record your interest in us as a possible future employer, customer or supplier
- implementation of security programs
- for (statistical) analysis and reporting (see 'Use of cookies' below)

What data do we process from you

During your interaction with Slaats Asten BV we ask or receive certain personal information. We collect only the information necessary for the delivery of our services. These data include, but are not limited to :your name, e-mail address, telephone number, job title, (business) address and / or (business) account number

- your preferences for future communication from Slaats.
- information about the products and / or services that you have purchased or have shown interest in
- depending on your preferences on social media sites: information about your online activities and social media profiles
- personal data collected via cookies (see 'Use of cookies' below)

Unless they have permission from parents or guardians, we do not intend to collect data from persons under the age of 16. However, we are not always able to check if someone is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in the (online) activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. If you are convinced that we have collected personal information about a minor without this permission, please contact us and we will delete this information.

We do not store your data longer than is permitted by law and is necessary for the purposes for which we process your personal data. The specific storage period depends on the nature of the personal data and the purpose for which they are processed. We take the protection of your data seriously and take appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification.

Share your information with others

In order to help you as best as possible, Slaats combines your personal information that we have because you are our client.

We may also share your personal data with business partners and other third parties. If your approval is required by law or if we deem this desirable, we will ask for your approval before we share your personal data. We will only share your personal data for the following purposes, but not limited to:

- For the provision or execution of our services

We engage business partners and other third parties to help us deliver our products and services to you. We will inform you about this cooperation in advance. To the extent that these third parties have access to your data, we have contractual and organizational measures taken to ensure that your data is protected and may only be used for specific purposes.

- For improving our services, website or advertisements

We use software from other parties to measure how well a new product page appeals to you. Phone calls can be recorded for quality purposes.

- To obtain feedback

We use survey agencies to hear how satisfied you are with our services.

- To perform a legal obligation

A police claim can oblige us to share your information with the police.

We do not sell your information to third parties. Only for sale or transfer of entire company. We require maximum efforts from our business partners in the protection of your personal data. In the agreements with our business partners, we determine for what purposes they may use your data and we require appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your data.

Your rights

You have the right to view, correct or delete the personal data that you share (if legally permitted and practically possible). You also have the right to withdraw your consent to data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Simac. You also have the right to data portability.

You can submit a request for this via the contact options described below. To prevent misuse, we can ask you to identify you. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within 4 weeks. We would also like to point out that you have the opportunity to file a complaint with the supervisory authority: the Dutch Data Protection Authority.

If you do not want to receive commercial messages from us, you can let us know by ticking the appropriate box on the form or by using the unsubscribe link in the e-mail you receive. We then block your data for commercial messages.

Use of cookies

We use cookies on our website. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit our website. We use cookies that are necessary for the technical operation of the website and for your ease of use. We also use cookies with which we can optimize our website. Where possible, we use the information we obtain through cookies to then provide you - with your permission - information that suits your interests. This involves the following cookies:

Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to map and analyze the use of our website. This concerns, among other things, visitor numbers and popular pages. We use this information to improve the quality and / or effectiveness of our website. The information generated by this cookie is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google maintains the Privacy Shield principles and is affiliated with the Privacy Shield program of the US Department of Commerce. This means that there is an appropriate level of protection for the processing of personal data.

If you do not want a cookie to be placed, you can block it. You can set this in the privacy settings of your internet browser. More information about switching on and off and removing cookies can be found through the help function of your browser.
